TICKETS - Tickets will **NOT** be issued this year. Members in good standing will be listed at the door. Those who buy Tishrei memberships, individual ticket holders and visitors with reciprocity letters will be listed as well.

In addition, arrangements are required for **all** non-members attending services, with the exception of the Family Services and Yom Kippur afternoon services. Military personnel and college students are always welcome at no cost, with appropriate I.D. If you do not already belong to the Temple Israel community please see our offer on page 4.

PLEASE NOTE: Pursuant to Temple Israel policy, members must be current in **ALL** financial obligations to the Temple in order to attend High Holy Day Services. If you have any questions about your status, please call the Temple President, Eric Lockshine at the Temple office and leave a message.

SPECIAL NEEDS – If you or a member of your family has special needs that require our attention during the High Holy Days, including accommodations for worshippers with disabilities, please call the Temple office. The Quiet Room is adjacent to the sanctuary, which allows participation in the service through a speaker system and picture window. Feel free to use the Quiet Room if you require a less stimulating environment for participation in the services or for your children. This is not our child care service.

PARKING at the Temple is limited, but Freedom Christian Center (our neighbor next door) has agreed to share their parking lot for the holidays.

TRANSPORTATION – If you are in need of a ride to Temple for services, please contact the Temple and we will try to help.

COURTESY AND RESPECT- Please do not wear heavy perfumes or colognes when coming to services. Many people have allergies and we want everyone to be comfortable. Also remember to silence all cell phones prior to entering the sanctuary.

ABRAHAM’S HARVEST - Once again the Jewish Federation of Brevard and Indian River Counties will be holding its annual Abraham’s Harvest Food Drive. You may pick up your Publix bag on Erev Rosh Hashanah or Rosh Hashanah and return it filled to the Temple on Kol Nidre or Yom Kippur. Or you can either make a donation to the Federation specifically for that purpose or you may purchase a gift card to any of the local supermarkets. You may drop either your check or gift cards at the Temple when you come for services and they will be sent to the Federation office.

CHILDCARE - Is available for children who are potty trained through age 10, during Erev Rosh Hashannah, Rosh Hashannah morning service, Kol Nidre, and Yom Kippur morning and afternoon services. Please let us know if you will be availing yourself of this service. Snacks will be provided during all childcare sessions. There is no charge for this service, but donations are certainly welcome. **If you do not make a reservation prior to Sept 15th babysitting may not be available.**

FLORAL FUND – As is our custom, the Bimah is dressed with beautiful fresh flowers for the holidays. If you would like to contribute to this fund, your donation would be appreciated by all who attend our services.
